One, non-renewable scholarship to a graduating senior from an Osceola County high school

- Demonstrated academic success ranking among the top 20% of his/her class
- Participation in community and volunteer service
- Involvement in extra-curricular activities

Terry & Beulah Forsberg Scholarship for Pine River Area Schools

Two, 2 year renewable scholarships and 1 non-renewable scholarship to graduating seniors from Pine River High School with financial need pursuing a career in a trade or a vocational career

Industrial Scholarship

One, non-renewable scholarship to a graduating senior from an Osceola County high school

- Demonstrated academic success ranking among the top 20% of his/her class
- Participation in community and volunteer service
- Involvement in extra-curricular activities
- Financial need is NOT a criterion

Dan Johnson Memorial Scholarship

One, non-renewable scholarship to a graduating senior from Pine River High School

- Strong work ethic
- GPA of 3.2 or better
- Worked during school
- Participates in community and/or school activities

Speaker Rick Johnson Scholarship

One, non-renewable scholarship to a graduating senior of an Osceola County high school or a graduating senior who resides in Osceola County

- ACT score must be listed
- Participation in extra-curricular and community activities

Rick and Cindy Johnson 4-H Scholarship

One, non-renewable scholarship of \$900 to a graduating senior of an Osceola County high school or a graduating senior who resides in Osceola County

- ACT score must be listed
- Financial need is NOT a criterion
- Active member of the Osceola County M.S.U. Extension 4-H

S.J. Martin Scholarship

One, non-renewable scholarship to an Osceola County high school graduate

- Participation in extra-curricular and community activities
- Rank in the top 25% of graduating of his/her class
- Preference is given to students pursuing a degree in education
- Preference is given to students entering their sophomore or junior year in college
- Preference is given to students who show financial need
- Constructive attitude
- Ability to relate well to others
- High moral character

Osceola Foundation FSU Scholarship

Four, non-renewable scholarships to a transfer student, adult student or graduating high school senior starting their first full year at Ferris State University.

- Minimum of 2.0 GPA

John and Mabel Outen Scholarship

Twelve, non-renewable scholarships to Osceola County high school graduates

- Demonstrated academic success ranking among the top 20% of his/her class
- Participation in community and volunteer service
- Involvement in extra-curricular activities

Dave Porteous Scholarship

Two, non-renewable scholarships to graduating Osceola County high school seniors or Osceola County high school graduates.

- Demonstrated academic success ranking among the top 20% of his/her class
- Participation in community and volunteer service
- Involvement in extra-curricular activities
- Must attend Michigan State University
- Must be a U.S. Citizen

Reed City General Federation of Women's Clubs Scholarship

One, non-renewable scholarship to a graduating female senior of an Osceola County high school

- Demonstrated academic success ranking among the top 20% of her class
- Participation in community and volunteer service
- Involvement in extra-curricular activities: school, church, and community
- Financial need is NOT a criterion

Reed City Rotary Scholarship

One, non-renewable scholarship to a graduating senior from an Osceola County high school

- Demonstrated academic success ranking among the top 20% of his/her class
- Participation in community and volunteer service
- Involvement in extra-curricular activities
- Financial need is NOT a criterion

Speaker Johnson's District 4-H Scholarship

One, non-renewable scholarship to a graduating high school senior residing in Mecosta, Missaukee, Osceola or Wexford County

- ACT score must be listed
- Active member of the County M.S.U. Extension 4-H
- Financial need is NOT a criterion
